Trees:

- ➤ 14- large Carrotwoods were pruned by Atlas Tree Service. The locations are 6 on 30th St, 3 on 31st St. and 5 on University Ave. These trees were constantly dropping seed pods and leaf litter every day.
- > 2318 30th St.- removed a Canary Island Date Palm and a Mex Fan Palm. (growing together in a tree well with a established Koleteria)

North Park Main Street (University Ave, North Park Way, Ray St, and 30thSt):

- > Graffiti removal, cleaning, etc. continues as normal.
- ➤ In process to move four environmental trash containers and replace with four green ornamental trash containers on University Ave.
- ➤ Light poles in process of being painted at 30th and Juniper St. (North side only)
- > Sticker removal continues.

El Cajon Boulevard:

- > Graffiti removal, cleaning, etc. continues as normal.
- Lantana and Day Lilies have been pruned back on the El Cajon Blvd. medians

North Park Gateway/Boundary Street and Ann Mudge Project:

> Graffiti removal, cleaning, ect. continues as normal.

Capital Projects:

➤ Switzer Canyon/30th Street Bridge Enhancement – This project is with Engineering and Capital Projects for preliminary design and still lacks for sufficient funding.

➤ Red Sidewalk Replacement on University Avenue – Engineer, Dean Marsden, says the project to fix the red sidewalk could happen sooner than 2015. Possibly in the next 12 months ahead of UAMP improvements. We will keep you posted if this happens.
